1. What was wobbly at the start?

- ✓ B) Lucas's tooth

Evidence: Paragraph 1: "Lucas had a wobbly tooth."

2. How did Lucas's tooth come out?

- ✓ B) It fell out when he bit an apple.

Evidence: Paragraph 2: "Lucas bit into an apple. Pop! His tooth fell right out."

3. What did Lucas put by his bed?

- ✓ C) His tooth in a small glass

Evidence: Paragraph 3: "Lucas put his tooth in a small glass by his bed."

4. What did Lucas find in the morning?

- ✓ A) A shiny gold coin

Evidence: Paragraph 4: "In its place was a shiny gold coin."

■ ■ Short Answer Answers

5. Who watched Lucas and how did they feel?

- ✓ Maya (his little sister) watched and giggled — she found it funny.

Evidence: Paragraph 1: "His little sister Maya watched and giggled."

6. What did Lucas say he would buy?
