enormous

Definition: very, very big

Sample sentence: The elephant was enormous.

Opposite: tiny / small

gentle

Definition: soft and careful, not rough

Sample sentence: She was gentle with the baby bird.

Opposite: rough / harsh

curious

Definition: wanting to learn or find out

Sample sentence: The curious cat looked in every box.

Opposite: bored / uninterested

gloomy

Definition: dark, sad, or dull

Sample sentence: The rainy day felt gloomy.
