■ Writing Checklist

Skill	What to look for	Check
Story Structure	Has a clear beginning, middle, and end — even if simple	Yes / Needs Work
Ideas	Story idea is original and makes sense	Yes / Needs Work
Sentences	Attempts at least one complete sentence per section	Yes / Needs Work
Capital Letters	Sentences begin with a capital letter	Yes / Needs Work
Punctuation	Sentences end with a period or exclamation mark	Yes / Needs Work
Drawing	Drawing matches the written sentence for that section	Yes / Needs Work
Title	Student gave the story a title	Yes / Needs Work
