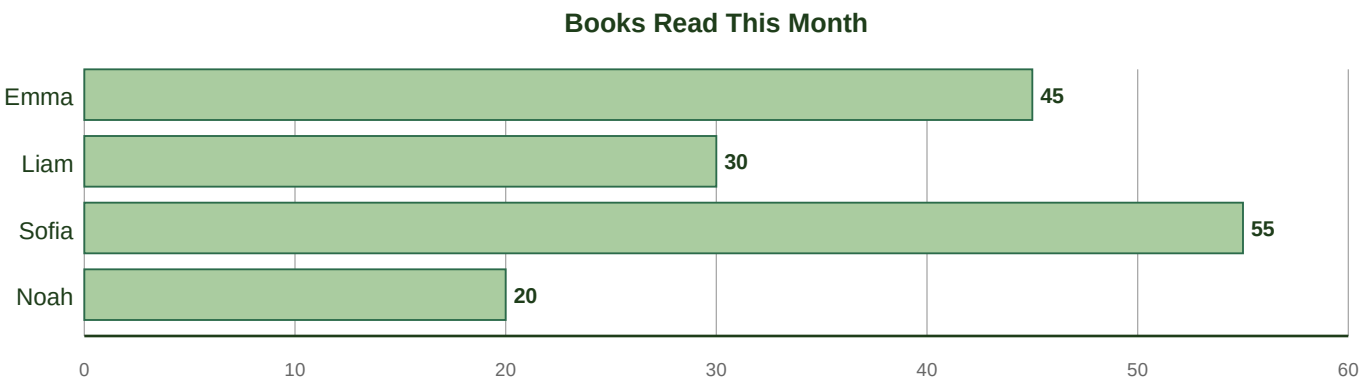

■ Part A — Read the bar graph. Answer the questions.



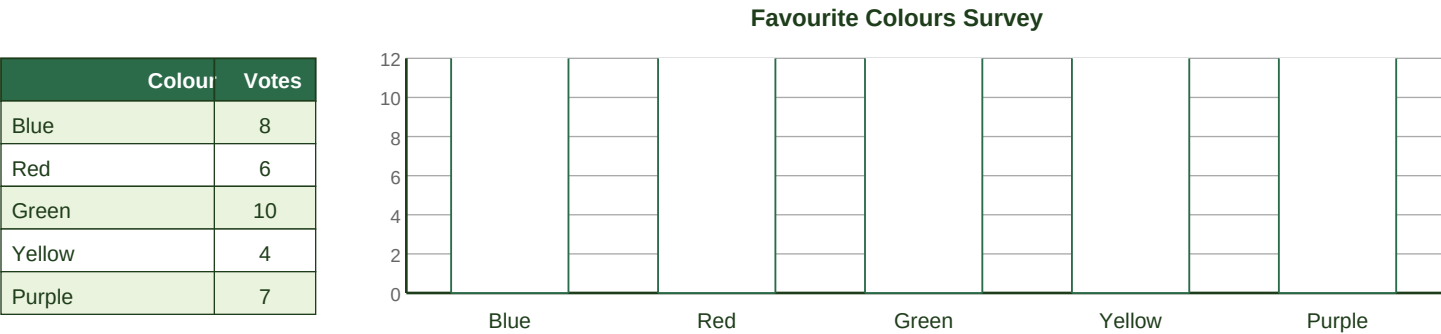
1. Who read the most books?

■ Part B — Use the data table to shade each bar on the graph. Then answer the questions.

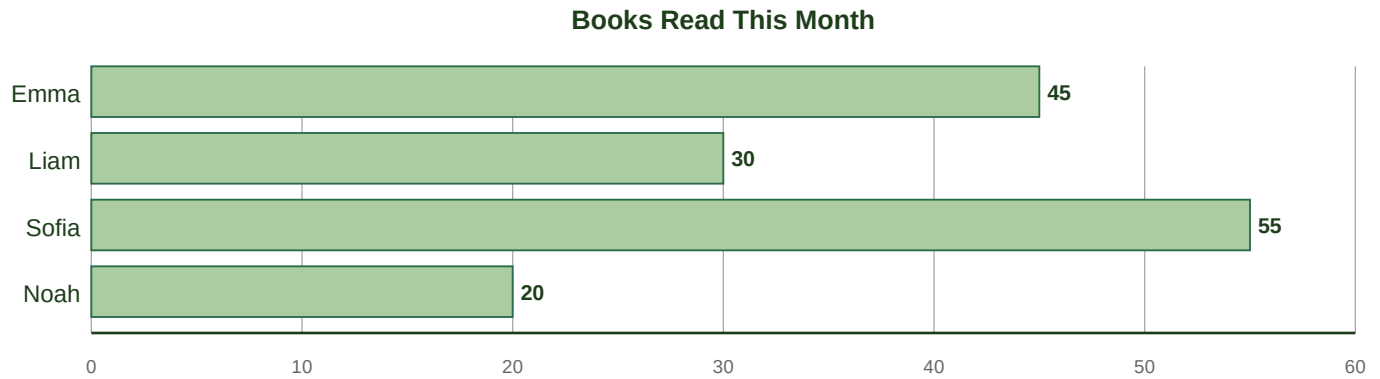


1. Which colour got the most votes?

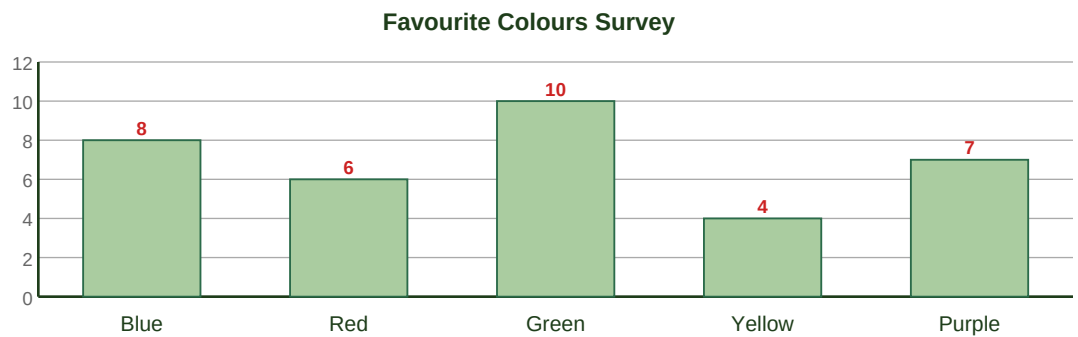
